

Some tips for dealing with possible bugs/ implementation of special requirements of editing work in LaTeX

1. Eliminating the red markings, like this:

There is an explanation about how to handle this issue, using the following:

```
\usepackage[hidelinks]{hyperref}
```

2. Make sure that your table of content has the line that refers to Bibliography chapter and that the page number for it is correct. There is a bug in LaTeX that makes it not to appear or to appear with a wrong page number.

Possible solution:

```
\usepackage[nottoc,notlot,notlof]{tocbibind}
```

And/or

```
\cleardoublepage
```

```
\addcontentsline{toc}{chapter}{Bibliography}
```

3. Hebrew abstract page has to be numbered with Hebrew letters (א"כ). In the Toc you need to mention its existence as the last row. The following may help:

```
\renewcommand{\thepage}{\aleph$}
```

or

```
\renewcommand{\thepage}{\aleph$}
```

4. In the Appendix section, for instance, for Appendix title to appear as whole and not only as A/B, **so instead of:**

**A Suppl
Efficie**

**B Suppl
Box O**

There will be:

**Appendix A Sup
ment for Effici**

Appendix B Sup

You need to do the following changes:

1. Delete the line: `\appendix`
Before the Appendix chapter
2. Add at the beginning of the document the following package:

```
\usepackage[toc]{appendix}
```

3. Add the Appendix chapters in the following way:

```
\begin{appendices}  
\chapter{An appendix} \chapter{An appendix}  
\end{appendices}
```
